SUBJECT: MMUSO 6TH PARLIAMENT AND STUDENT EXECUTIVE COUNCIL ELECTIONS

Following the dissolution of the 5th MMUSO Parliament (2021/2022) on 2nd February, 2023 and pursuant to MMUSO Constitution (Revised) 2021 Article 69 b (i), notice is hereby given to all MMUSO members on this Thursday 2nd February, 2023 that:

- (i) The 6th Electoral College elections shall be held on Thursday 23rd February, 2023 from 6.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.
- (ii) The 6th Student Executive Council elections shall be held on Friday 24th February, 2023 from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.

Pursuant to Article 36 of MMUSO Constitution, the names of nominated members of Students Parliament representing Persons with Disabilities, International Students and Religious Groups shall be submitted to MEC Chairperson in SHA 018 not later than Monday 20th February, 2023.

NOMINATION

All interested persons are hereby advised to collect nomination papers and clearance forms from the Office of the Dean of Students, SHA 018 on Thursday 2nd February, 2023 from 2.00 p.m.

Duly filled nomination papers and clearance forms should be submitted to the Office of the Dean of Students, SHA 018 not later than 9th February, 2023 by 4.00pm.

Eligibility Criteria

Pursuant to Article 19 read together with Article 37, all those aspiring for nomination of MMUSO Student Executive Council and Parliament, shall meet the following criteria:

- a) A bonafide student of MMUST.
- b) Have registered in the Electoral College (School, Campus, Resident or Non Resident)/Parliamentary area the member seeks to represent.
- c) Continuing students must have a minimum average grade of 60% in the immediate previous academic year university examinations.
- d) First year students intending to contest are eligible to vie for the above posts.
- e) Not be a member of Students Electoral Commission.
- f) Have been cleared by the Electoral Commission.
- g) Not have been proven guilty in a disciplinary case in the university.
- h) Not have held position in SEC or Parliament for two terms in MMUST or any other University in Kenya.
- i) A nominee for the representative of Persons with Disability (abled differently) MUST possess a valid identification from the National Council for Persons with Disabilities.
- j) A nominee for the representative of International Students MUST have a Kenyan Student Pass from the department of Immigration.
- k) A nominee form religious groups MUST be approved by the respective Chaplain.

Take Note that:

- After nominations candidates shall automatically be disqualified from elections if they incite
 other students to use violence, boycott lectures, threaten or ridicule any member of staff
 or students.
- Candidates will also be disqualified if proved that they use alcohol or drugs to enhance their speech/personality in public or use money to buy the electorate.
- A list of all duly nominated candidates will be posted on notice boards on Monday 13th
 February, 2023

CAMPAIGNS

Approved campaign period shall be between Thursday 14th and Tuesday 21st February, 2023.

VOTING

- Only those in the voter's register will be allowed to vote.
- To vote, one should produce a valid school ID card and or a National Identity card.

Please co-operate in order to facilitate the smooth running and successful completion of the polling exercise.
