VICE CHANCELLOR'S ROUND UP FOR THE WEEK ENDING,

- The Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) has selected Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST) to assist in designing the proposed standard for indigenous knowledge and cultural economies. On Monday, 28th August, 2023, the Institute of Indigenous Knowledge and Cultural Studies and Climate Change (IIKCSCC) hosted a one-day Workshop for Indigenous Knowledge Holders (IKHs) drawn from different parts of Kakamega County. The IKHs, who interacted closely with the KEBS Representative-Mr. Micah Rachuonyo, and MMUST scholars, showcased various traditional products including herbal medicine, honey, mosquito repellent candies, ointments, beauty products and vegetables.
- MMUST staff have been advised to adopt a proactive planning approach in order to ensure a secure financial future and retirement. This was during a retirement planning seminar organized by the MMUST Staff Retirement Benefits Scheme. The event took place on 30th August 2023 at Bishop Nicholas Stam-Kakamega. This is a University funded exercise that enables staff to set goals, make strategic decisions, budget effectively, manage risks, invest wisely, and build a solid foundation for a fulfilling retirement.
- On 31st August 2023, the Vice Chancellor visited various Schools at the University during the admission process to personally welcome the First Year students to MMUST. Over 3000 students have been admitted so far.
- MMUST has kicked off implementation of the university council 90-day plan. This took place in a Workshop held on 31st August, 2023 at Bishop Stam, which saw the top Management, Deans, Directors and Coordinators brainstorm ideas on how best to roll out the plan.
