- Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST), has acquired a Nitrogen Generating Plant in a bid to enhance research and training in the School of Natural Sciences (SONAS). The plant is set to supply liquid Nitrogen to the Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR) machine, which is housed in the Department of Pure and Applied Chemistry. It was brought to the University on 12th April, 2023, by a team from Scientific Laboratory Supplies (SLS), and was officially received by the Vice Chancellor.
- MMUST is dominating the sports sector in the country as it achieved position two (2) overall during the final match of the Kenya Universities Sports Association (KUSA) Games. The University recorded exemplary performances in Handball Women against JKUAT (24-20), and Soccer Women against Kisii University (5-4) and emerged winners in the respective categories.
