
- Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology's School of Education and Walter Sisulu University's Faculty of Education and School Development scholars are set to conduct joint research, postgraduate activities and publishing in a bid to exercise their mandate as institutions of higher learning. This joint initiative was made clear during the five-day Workshop which took place at MMUST from Monday, 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2022 to Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.
- The Vice Chancellor, Prof. Solomon Shibairo, on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2022 joined the Governor, Vihiga County, H.E Hon. Dr. Wilberforce Ottichilo to celebrate 'World Water Day.' The event was held at Kegondi health centre in Vihiga County. On the same day, the VC also officially opened the Weversity SACCO Society indoor games tournament held at the University Sports grounds.
- MMUST's researcher, Dr. Damaris Ochanda spearheaded a two-day training of Research Assistants on data collection ahead of the field research '**Strengthening Community Strategy for Enhancing Accessibility to Care among Patients with Non-Communicable Diseases in Kakamega County during COVID-19 Pandemic**'. This event was held on Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at the Main Catering Unit 002 (MCU).
- On 24<sup>th</sup> March 2022, a team of experts from Malteser International, led by Mr. Charles Aywak paid a courtesy call to the offices of the DVC, Academic and Student Affairs (ASA) and Planning Research and Innovation (PRI) respectively. They were in the University for a two-day assessment and quantification of human resource capacity in the Skills Laboratory at the School of Nursing, Midwifery and Paramedical Sciences (SONMAPS). They will also equip the Skills Laboratory, which is aimed at enhancing basic and advanced skills for Nursing and Health Sciences students. This is as a result of the partnership between MMUST and Malteser

International, which will also see a number of staff from the Skills laboratory receive further training.

- The University Ombudsman, Rev. Prof. Judith Achoka, today, Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> March 2022, organized a Capacity Building training for all Administrators and Secretaries. The training, which was aimed at equipping the frontline workers with skills to perform their roles and offer efficient service delivery was conducted by the Commission on Administrative Justice (CAJ).
