**VICE CHANCELLOR'S ROUND UP FOR THE WEEK ENDING,**



- Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST)-School of Computing and Informatics (SCI) organized a two-weeks training to second year students, who will soon be going out for attachments. According to the Chairperson of the Department of Computer Science, this exercise is aimed at imparting students with practical skills, which she says is a major requirement for employment as Computer Science professionals and supplements the theoretical lessons they have been undertaking.
- The School of Business and Economics (SOBE) empowered its researchers with requisite skills in writing winning grant proposals. This was during a one-day grant writing workshop that was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> May, 2023 at the Golf Hotel Kakamega. The workshop entailed in-depth discussions on the grant writing process, including understanding the purpose of grants, identifying funding sources and the importance of effective proposals.
- MMUST is hosting a training workshop for Teachers of French from the Region. The training workshop which is being facilitated by experts from MMUST and other institutions began on 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 and will go on up to Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2023. This workshop was organized by a research team from the French Section of the Department of Language and Literature Education, School of Arts and Social Sciences (SASS).
- On 24<sup>th</sup> May 2023, MMUST held an online workshop to review the University's preparedness for the implementation of the Competence Based Education (CBE) programme. The aim of this webinar was to investigate the level of preparedness of the University for the implementation of the Competency-Based Education. The webinar was organized by the Director, Research and Postgraduate Support.

- A team of researchers led by the Associate Dean, School of Education, Prof. Kennedy Bota held a research dissemination workshop on 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 at Mbale Boys High School. Their research titled '*Examining Parents' and Teachers' Views In Relation to the Core Values of the Competency Based Curriculum*', is among the many researches funded by the University Research Fund (URF).
