- Masinde Muliro University of Science and Technology (MMUST)-School of Computing and Informatics (SCI) organized a two-weeks training to second year students, who will soon be going out for attachments. According the Chairperson of the Department of Computer Science, this exercise is aimed at imparting students with practical skills, which she says is a major requirement for employment as Computer Science professionals and supplements the theoretical lessons they have been undertaking.
