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SUMMARY

I have over 25 years of experience in educational institution and in pastoral work: a high school teacher for 8 years, a pastor and lecture for 13 years. Since my appointment as a lecture, I have contributed to the academia by publishing a book of university level, and published over 15 articles in peer reviewed journals.
